

POSITION: Food Service Worker

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma or equivalent
2. Passes any health examination required by the Board of Education
3. Demonstrate aptitude or competence for assigned responsibility

REPORTS TO: Food Service Director

JOB GOAL: To serve the students attractive and nutritious meals in an atmosphere of efficiency, cleanliness, and friendliness.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Assists in the preparation and service of food in a quick, cooperative manner with a pleasant attitude toward staff, students, and visitors.
2. Assumes responsibility for seeing that during meal service periods the supply of food offered is replenished regularly.
3. Assists in the daily clean up of the kitchen and service areas.
4. Loads and operates dishwasher and cleans pots and pans.
5. Performs major cleaning of refrigerators, freezers, and storerooms at regularly scheduled intervals as designated by the food service director.
6. Assumes responsibility for storage and disposal of unused foods.
7. Supervises special meal preparations for district sponsored events or approved community groups as directed by the food service director.
8. Will wear hair nets at all times when preparing and serving food.
9. Attends the annual Open House held in the fall of each school year.
10. Demonstrates appropriate personal hygiene that contributes to healthy and sanitary conditions in the kitchen and cafeteria.
11. Performs any other job related duties as assigned by the food service director who schedules all daily job assignments.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary and work year to be established annually by the Board of Education.

EVALUATION: Performance of this position will be evaluated with provisions of the board policy on evaluation of classified personnel.
